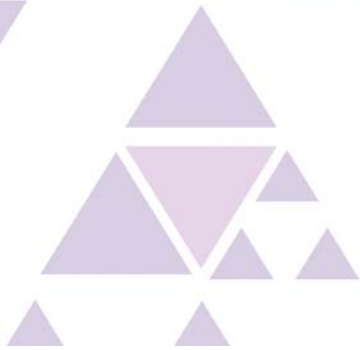

1.0 TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE OFFER OF ADMISSION (ACADEMIC SESSION 2022/2023)

This offer is subject to the following terms and conditions:

1.1 As registered students of USM, students are subject to the following terms and conditions.

1.1.1 Must adhere to:

- a. All State Laws;
- b. Laws and Constitutions of Universiti Sains Malaysia as set out in the University and University College Act 1971 (AUKU 1971);
- c. Methods of Universiti Sains Malaysia (Discipline of Students 1999);
- d. University Statutes, University Acts and Rules and so on (Nomination for Student Representative Council Election) and
- e. The decisions of the Board of Governors of the University, the University Senate and the relevant School Councils.

1.1.2 Must be willing to pay all tuition fees and other fees subject to the University's Financial Regulations.

1.1.3 Must be neatly dressed and in accordance with the requirements of the pursued Programme (refer to the dress code ethics).

1.1.4 Must take part in the academic, cultural, sports, social and community services by the University to ensure the balance between character building and academic achievement.

1.2 Obtained at least:

- IELTS minimum Band 5.0 **or**
- TOEFL iBT minimum score of 40 **or**
- TOEFL Essentials Online minimum score of 7.5 **or**
- Cambridge English : Advanced (CAE) minimum score of 154 **or**
- Cambridge English : Proficiency (CPE) minimum score of 154 **or**
- Cambridge English : Linguaskill Online minimum score of 154 **or**
- PTE Academic / PTE Academic (Online) minimum score of 47 **or**
- Malaysian University English Test minimum Band 3.5 **or**
- Candidates from countries where English is the official language **or**
- Candidate from an institution in which the medium instruction is English;

1.3 Additional Requirements Following the Covid-19 Epidemic

1.3.1 Students are required to defer registration and must inform the Student Admission Unit, Academic Management Division, Registry. Kindly submit related documents if you:

- a. Experience symptoms of COVID-19 before or during the day of registration.
- b. Have received the Home Surveillance and Observation Order (Prevention and Control of Infectious Diseases Act 1988) by the Malaysian Ministry of Health (MOH/KKM) within 7 days before registration.
- c. Have close contact with patients who have been confirmed positive for COVID-19 or individuals who are still under investigation for COVID-19 within 7 days prior to registration.
- d. Any matters involving the risk of COVID-19 will be handled in accordance with the SOP set by USM Nerve Centre.

1.4 Students shall also declare any involvement in any association, political party, trade union or any current grouping. At the moment of being a Registered Student, the student is subject to the terms set forth under item 1.1.1 (b) above.

1.5 If a student accepts an entry and withdraws the offer after registering as a **University Registered Student, Non-Recurring Fees will not be refunded.**

1.6 Students are **REQUIRED** to attend the "PIMPIN SISWA" Course organized by the University. The date and venue will be informed later by the Students and Alumni Development Affairs Division (BHEPA), USM.

1.7 The student's name will be dropped or cancelled, if the student is found to have Student status at any other higher education institutions.

1.8 Students are **REQUIRED** to participate in all activities of the Orientation Programme. All Year 1 students are **REQUIRED** to stay in the hostel during the Orientation Programme.

1.9 The University reserves the right to reject this application, withdraw an offer or otherwise direct the student to depart from Universiti Sains Malaysia and the sponsor reserves the right to withdraw any scholarship or loan offer at any time if any evidence or copy of the certificates submitted is incorrect.

1.10 Students are **REQUIRED** to report themselves as students on the designated date. In the event of failure to do so, permission shall be obtained first from the Registrar in writing. If the University does not receive any feedback within **two (2) weeks**, the offer will automatically be withdrawn.

REMINDER

The University will not send any reminders to students regarding the offer of admission. This offer will be withdrawn if the student fails to meet the above requirements.

2.0 STUDENT CARD

The Student Card is the official ID card of USM students. Students are **REQUIRED** to wear and display this card at all times as proof of identity while on campus and for all official arrangements with the University. The Student Card is not transferable or for other party's use. Student Card Application is divided into the following categories: -

- A. New Student registration:** Students are REQUIRED to upload their passport-sized photo (with white background) online via the Matric Card Registration System.
- B. Lost cards:** Students must report to the Security Department office before submitting a New Student Card Application Form with a report of the loss.
- C. New Application:** In the case of card damage or change of Course, students must surrender their existing student cards with a New Student Card Application form.

The New Student Card Application Form can be obtained from the **Student Admission Unit Counter, Level 2, Chancellory Building, USM, Penang**. All Completed New Student Card Application Forms must be submitted to the **Student Admission Unit**.

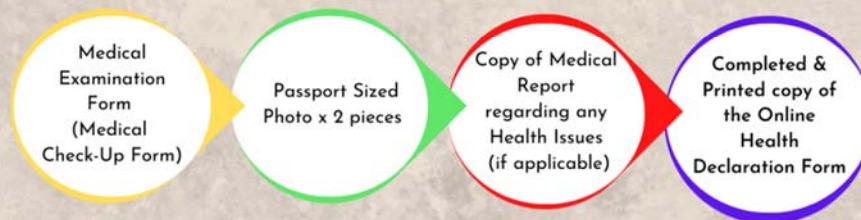

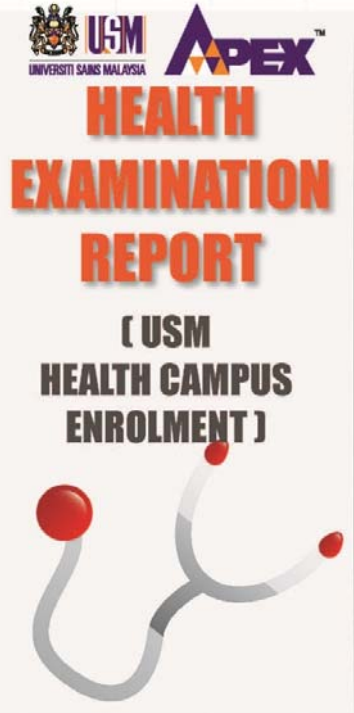

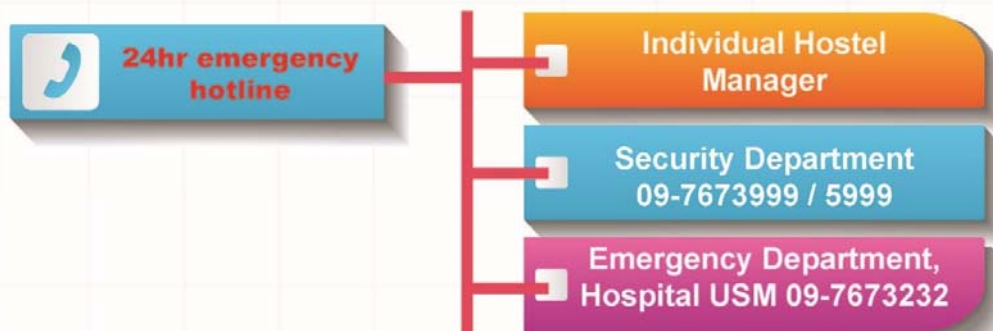

4.0 UNIVERSITY FEES PAYMENT REGULATIONS

4.1

UNIVERSITY FEES

Student fees are divided into the following five (5) components:

a. Registration Fee

Charged once only to new students and paid upon accepting the offer. For Non-Citizen, Registration Fees are inclusive of Personal Bond amounting to USD1,000.00. Personal Bond will be refunded upon graduation/ withdrawal after taking into account the arrears of debt to the University. Registration fees are not refundable if the student withdraws from studies.

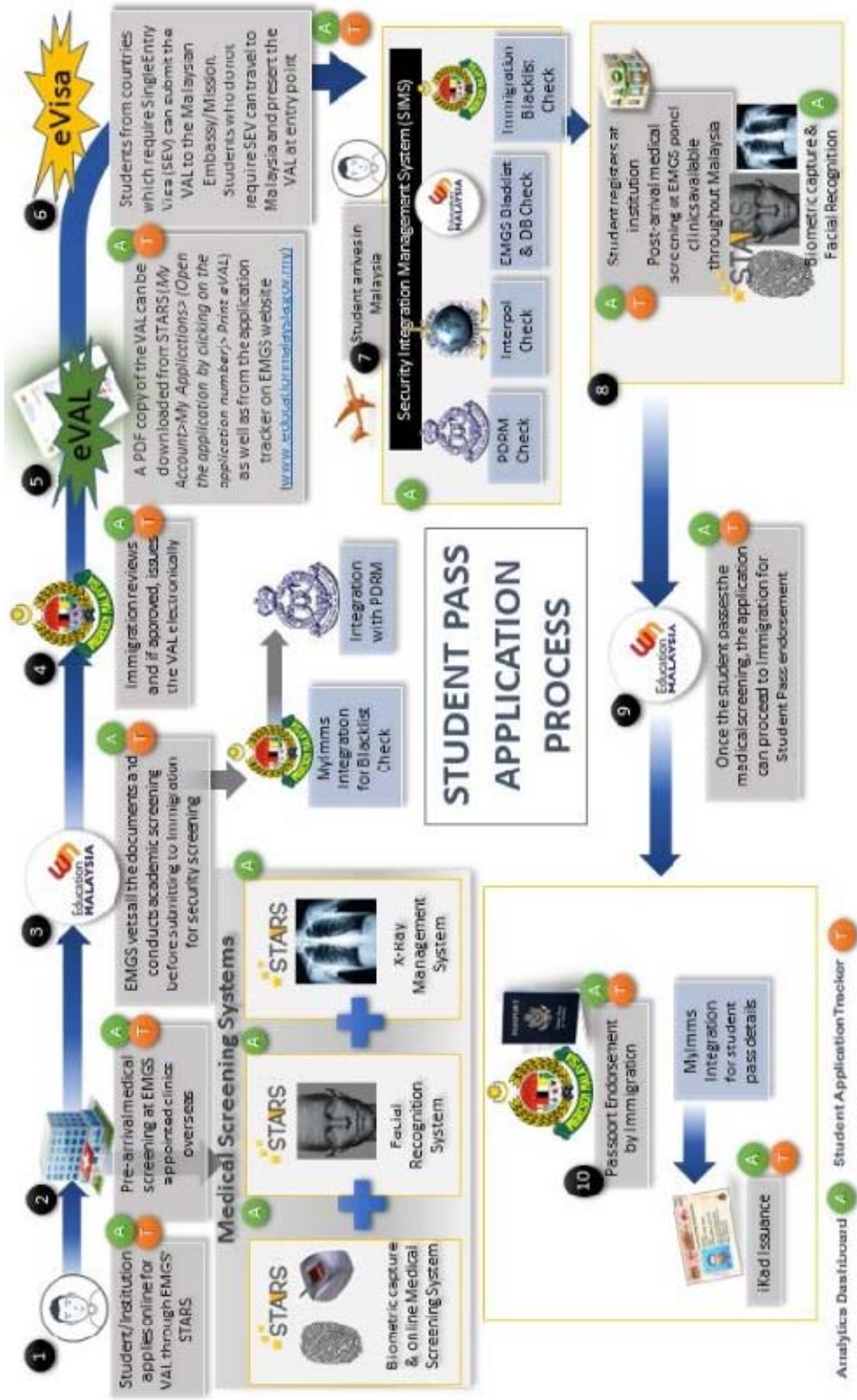
Application through Institution (STARS Student Application Registration System)

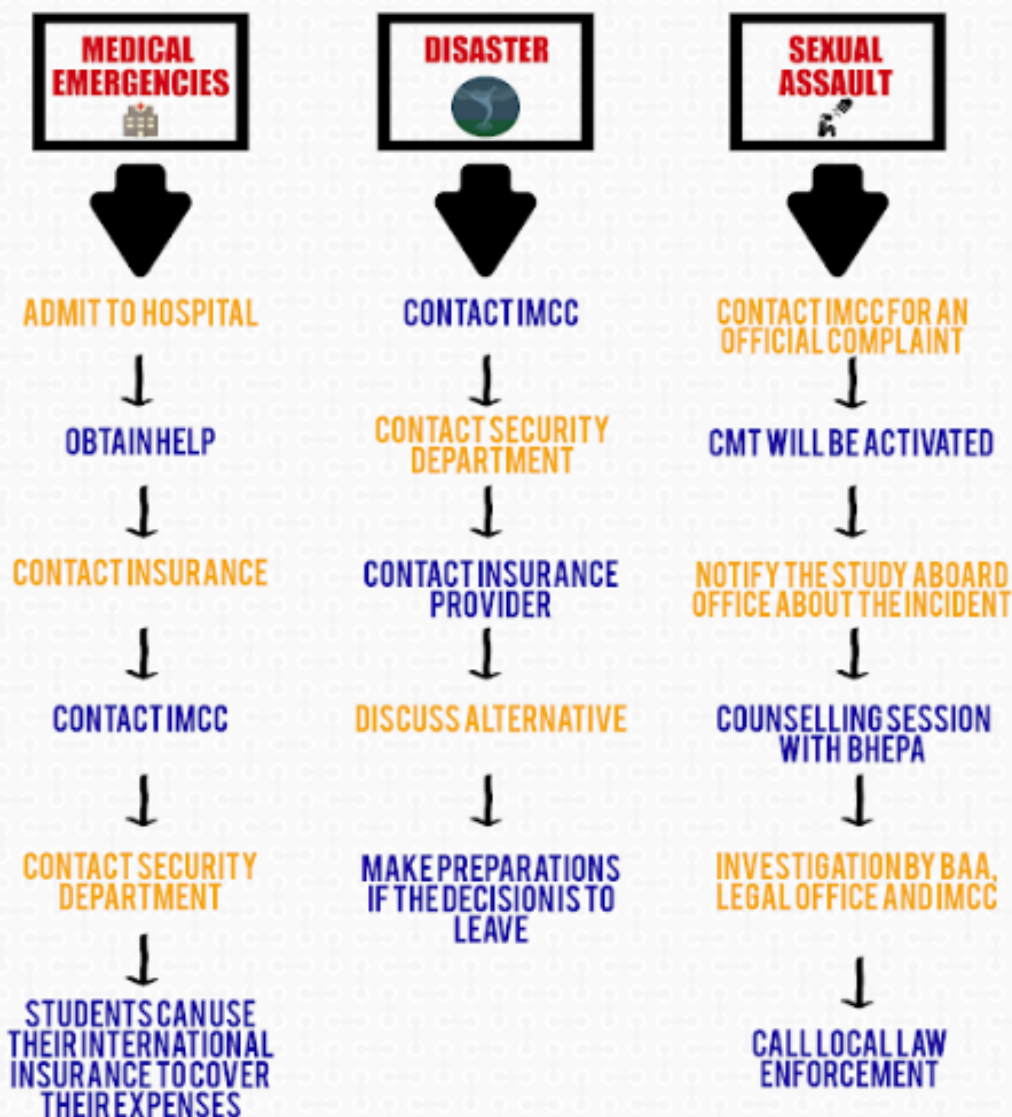

AGENDA

The H.E.B.A.T agenda is a shift in the USM education system which gives focus to five elements in the shift, namely Holistic, Entrepreneurial, Balanced, Articulate and Thinking. Besides Articulation, the letter A also represents the Malay word 'Akhlaq' (Morality), which stands for good conduct and behaviour. This agenda aspires to nurture people with high integrity, who can meet the needs of the current market and are able to lead the country, thus, the world in the future.

This agenda was introduced to form, develop and strengthen the personality of future USM graduates through their involvement in accredited academic programmes (as supervised by the Academic and International Division) and non-academic activities (as supervised by the Student and Alumni Development Affairs Division) that are interconnected as a comprehensive and integrated system that does not only focus on certain aspects.

Three out of the five elements of the shift, which are H.E.B, are shifts that have been adapted from the Malaysian Education Development Plan (Higher Education) 2015-2025 (PPPMPT 2015-2025). USM has added two more elements which are A and T to produce students who will be able to drive the first three elements through good articulation, which is the expression of ideas or feelings with words using effective thinking techniques.

These five elements have been detailed into fifteen attributes as per the glossary table below. Fifteen attributes that all USM students need to polish on in preparation for the world of work after completing their studies and graduating. All of these H.E.B.A.T attributes are applied in the teaching, learning, monitoring and evaluation process through creditable academic programmes and non-academic activities which are carried out during the study period.

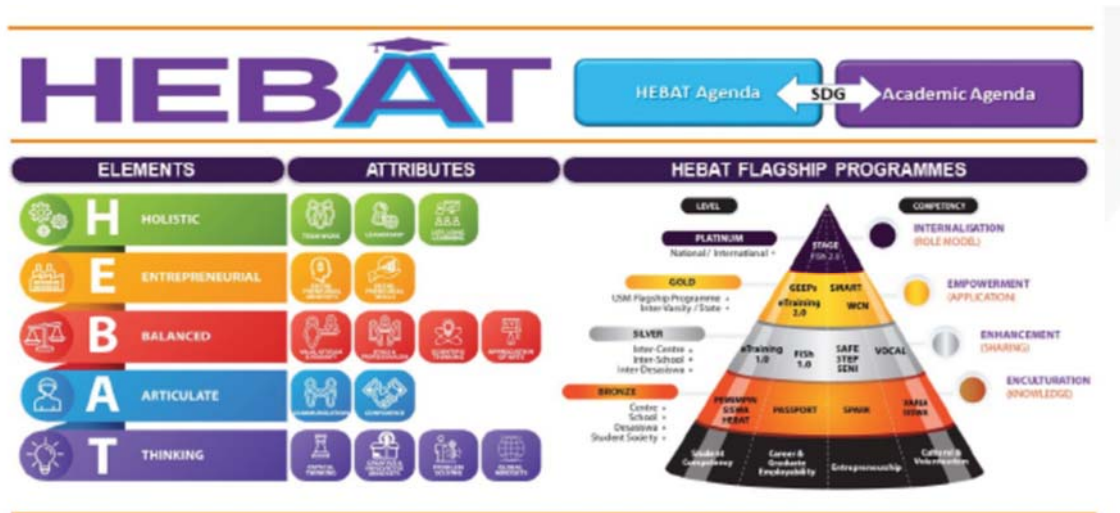

Programmes/Activities under the H.E.B.A.T Agenda or better known as HEBAT Flagship Programs (HFP) are dynamically designed starting with the Acculturation Level (competence in basic knowledge), the Strengthening Level (knowledge sharing programmes/activities), the Empowerment Level (producing ideas/products) and the Reinforcement Level (appreciation as an example (role-model)). This framework is aligned with the USM Academic Agenda and Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

All non-academic activities throughout the study period will be recorded through the My Continuous Student Development (MyCSD) System. This MyCSD data will be analyzed and evaluated to display H.E.B.A.T achievements (Bronze, Silver, Gold, Platinum) through the H.E.B.A.T Neuron System Campus Online Portal. The scorecard through the H.E.B.A.T dashboard helps students see their achievements for each semester and generates the self-efficacy details. The highlight of the H.E.B.A.T Agenda is the H.E.B.A.T Medal Award which will be awarded at the USM Convocation Ceremony. Efforts to shift the higher education system through the H.E.B.A.T Agenda are expected to increase the visibility and marketability of USM students.

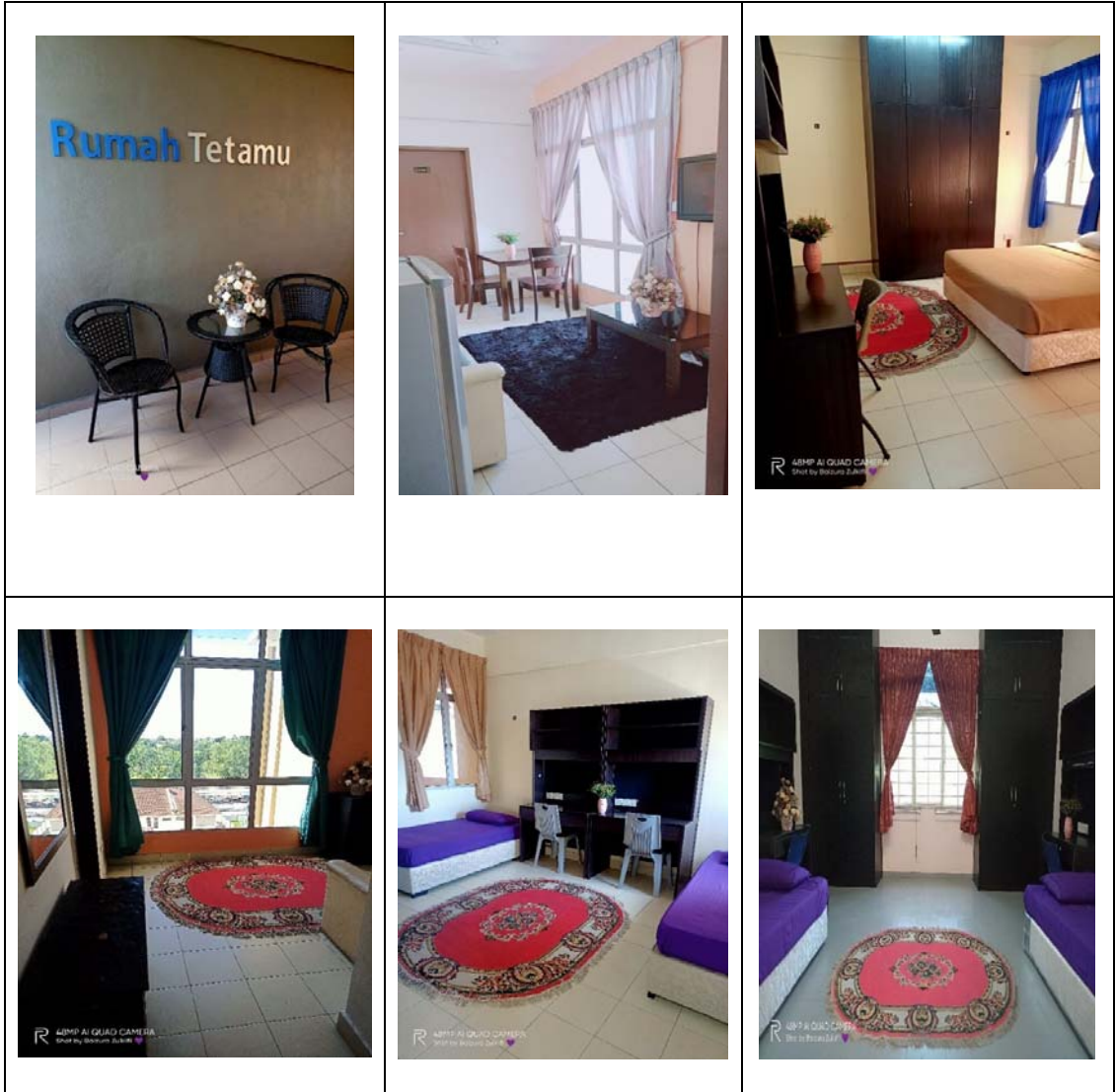

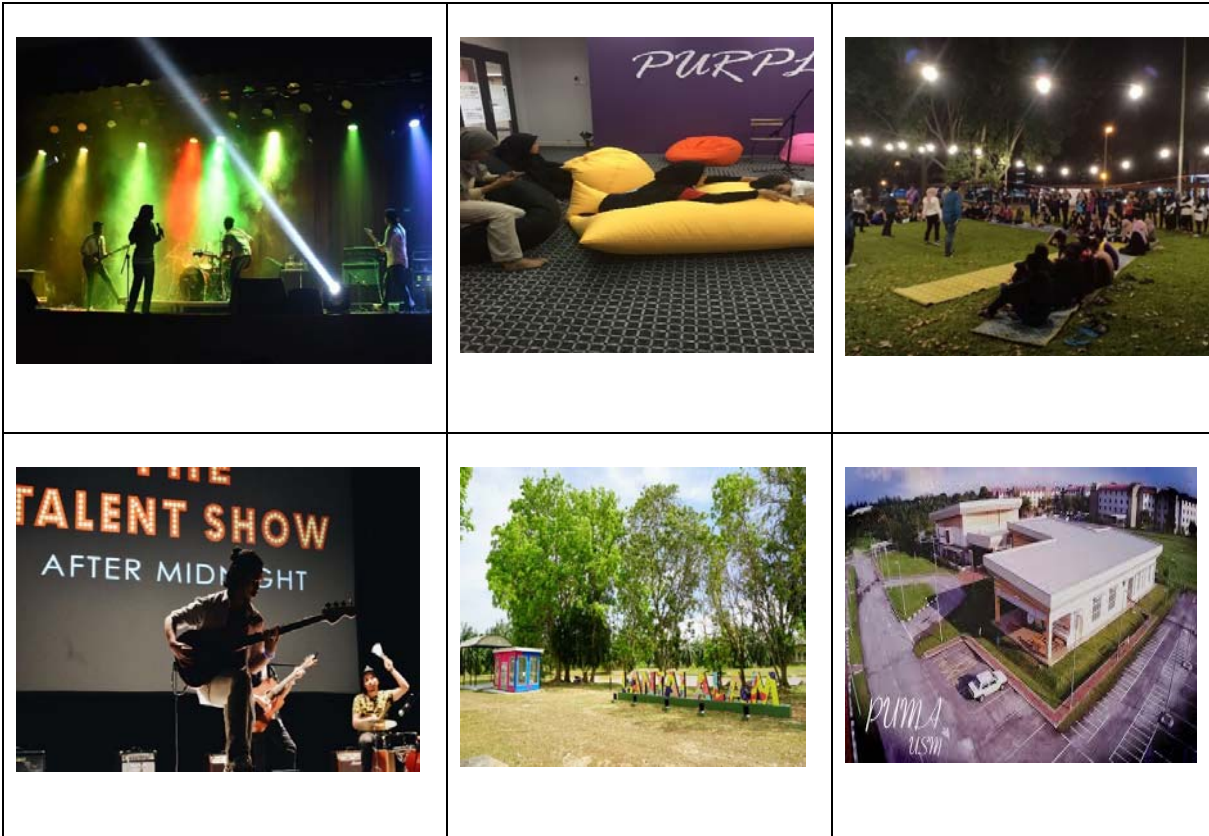

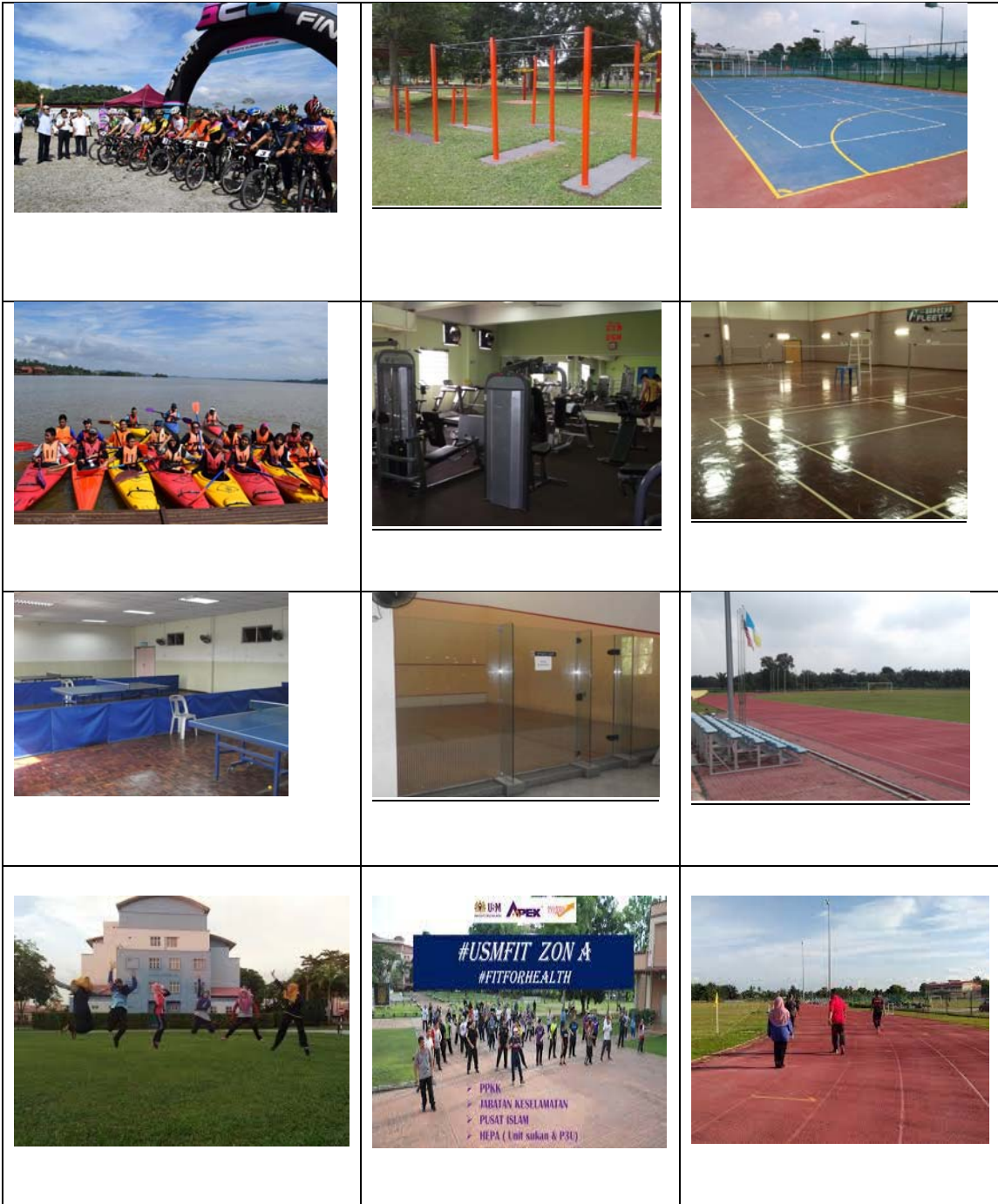

SPORTS ACTIVITIES IN ENGINEERING CAMPUS





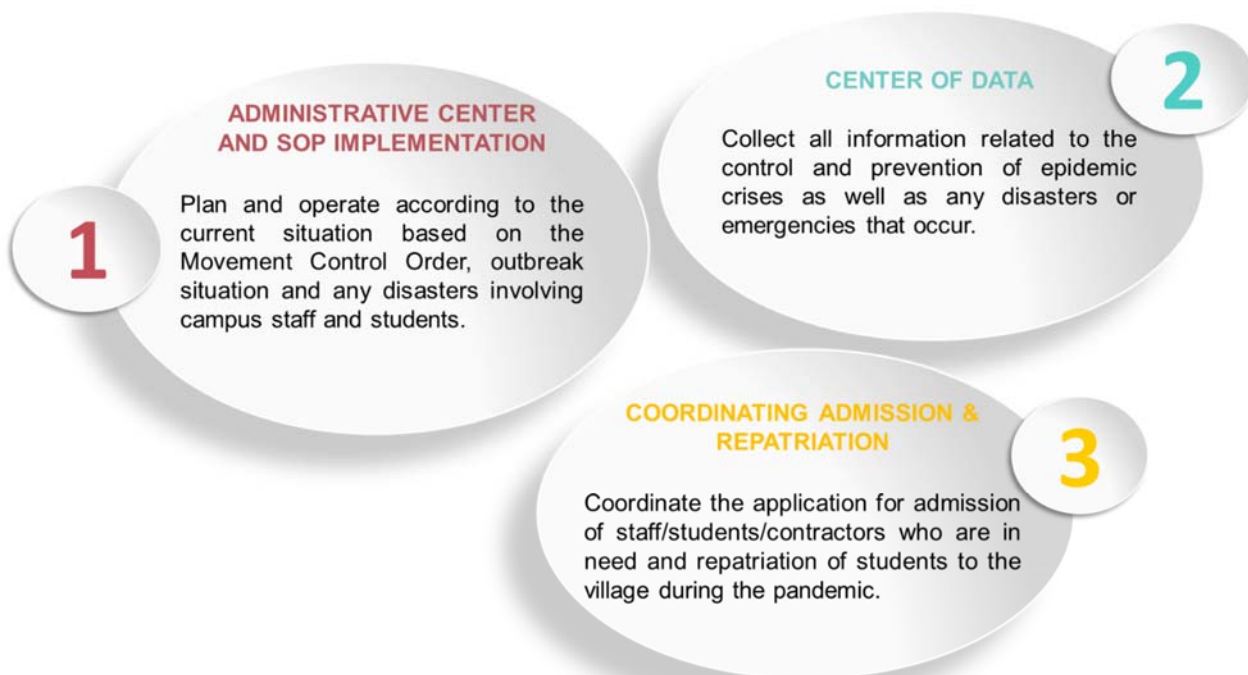




14.0 NERVE CENTRE

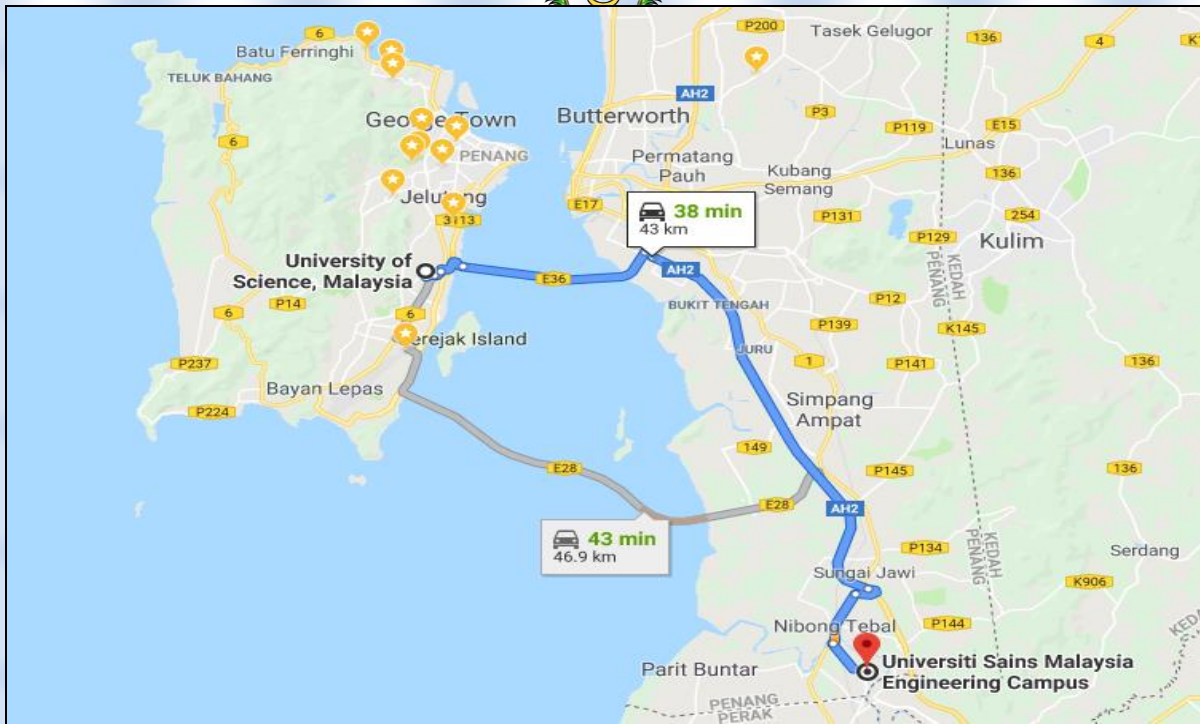
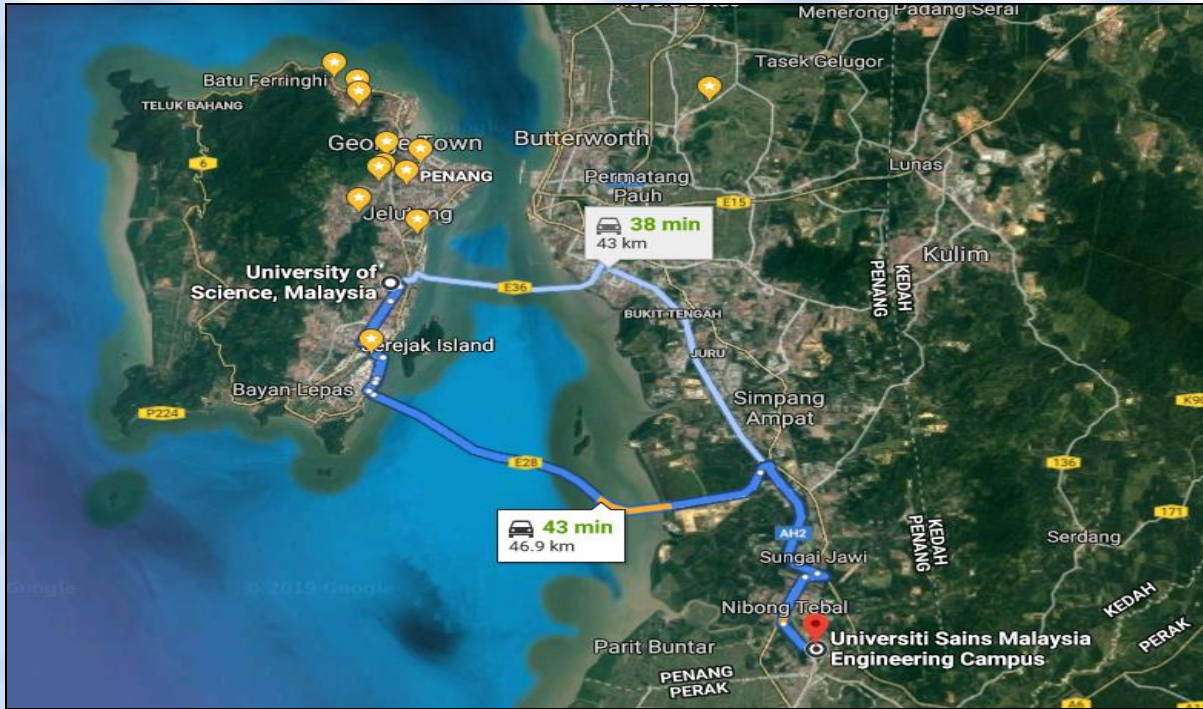

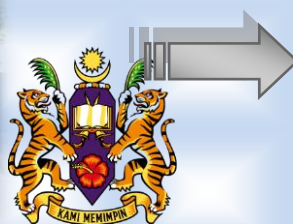




LOCATION MAP FOR MAIN CAMPUS USM & ENGINEERING CAMPUS USM
