

RETURNING OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS TO CAMPUS FROM HOME COUNTRY

New & existing international students who have obtained eVal-electronic Visa Approval Letter & Entry Approval Letter (EAL) from EMGS/Malaysia Immigration Department and plan to enter Malaysia from 2021 onwards must inform their travel information to USM via the International Mobility & Collaboration Centre (IMCC) for transportation assistance arrangement to pick-up at NADMA Quarantine Stations/Centres (Hotels around Kuala Lumpur) to USM after completing their quarantine period (7/10 days).

International students who are fully vaccinated with complete dose(s) of COVID-19 vaccination and wish to apply for Home/Residence Quarantine under the Home Surveillance Order (HSO) can submit their application to the Ministry of Health. Visit <https://hso.moh.gov.my/outbreak-portal-hqa/index> for application that must be made 7-10 days prior to date of entry into Malaysia

It is optional for NEW students to stay inside campus AFTER the mandatory quarantine, where they can opt to find accommodation outside campus if they prefer. However if they prefer to be inside campus, NEW UNDERGRADUATE students have been secured 1 academic session (2 semesters) while POSTGRADUATE students need to apply through USM Housing Accommodation Centre (HAC) email at postgrad_hac@usm.my.

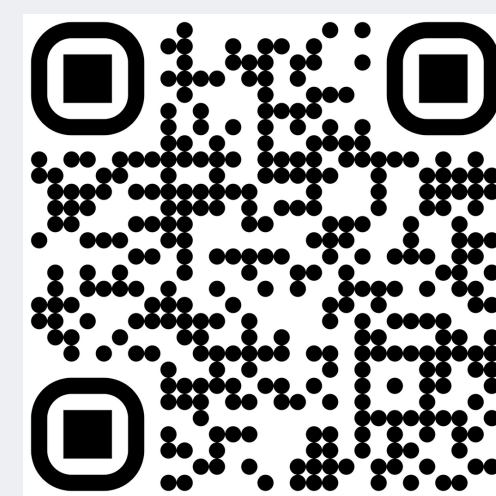
An online form at <https://forms.gle/K3wNk2mRzakqUQ6P7> should be filled once you :

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: For the pickup by university representatives, where will the students go after reaching campus?

A: Students will be brought to Health Facility (Pusat Sejahtera) to complete the health assessment tool to those who have completed 7/10 days from NADMA quarantine centres or HSO (Home Surveillance Order / Home quarantine). Students must provide the clearance letter given by the Ministry of Health (KKM) to proceed with Medical Checkup for NEW student and obtain medical confirmation letter for student pass endorsement OR release letter for existing student to return to their respective hostel rooms.

Q: What is the arrangement for approved Home Surveillance Order (HSO)?

A : After receiving HSO approval from KKM, students are required to fill up the form as above and make own arrangement to approved HSO location. Students are required to report to Pusat Sejahtera (PS) after completing the mandatory quarantine by providing a clearance letter given by Ministry of Health(KKM).

Q: Can PETAS (Off-Campus) students who have completed 7/10 days quarantine at NADMA or HSO obtain the release letter (surat pelepasan) the next day if their arrival is after Pusat Sejahtera (PS) closed?

A: They will need to be isolated at their own homes, come to PS the next day after approval via form A (via campusonline) which needs to be applied on the day of arrival to Nerve Centre. Choose "Others" with remark: To complete health assessment and clearance by Pusat Sejahtera.

Q: Students staying on campus, where do they go if PS is closed upon reaching/arrival at campus?

A: Students will be brought to an isolation block, so that they will go to Pusat Sejahtera the next day to complete the assessment.

Q : I don't have CampusOnline as I am a new student, how can I apply to enter campus?

A: Students will need to submit manual Form A (Borang A) downloadable using the QR code and email to n.afiqah@usm.my.
