Programme dates

Ordinary courses:

- Course period: 23 June – 23 July 2020
- Exam period
 - Home assignments/mini projects: 23/24 June - 24 July 2020 (Please note that exam will start on the first teaching day and will run in parallel with the course)
 - 4 hours written sit-in exam: 27 July – 31 July 2020
- Please note that in order to help students get maximum value from ISUP courses, instructors provide a reading or a small number of readings to be read before the start of classes with a related task or tasks in class 1 in order to 'jump-start' the learning process.

SHORT COURSES!

We will also offer 2 graduate/Master's courses and 1 undergraduate/Bachelor course of 3-week in-class teaching at ISUP in 2020 (courses will be available in the Course Catalogue in December).

Exam assignments (home assignments/mini projects) will have to be submitted one week after the last day of class. The courses are intensive, students cannot take two of such courses simultaneously and cannot be taken together with ordinary 5-week in-class teaching courses.

- Two nominated students in the summer programme count as one regular semester place regardless of the number of courses students take

Admission requirements

- If any, students must fulfill the course prerequisites (Please consult the course descriptions)
- Students of good academic standing. Exchange students are not required to submit any proof of English proficiency, but since all courses are taught in English and at a high academic level it is highly recommended to have a strong command in both oral and written English otherwise it might be difficult to follow the courses and pass the exams. We trust that our partners will nominate students who have good English skills and can successfully complete the Programme.

Housing

- Accommodation/housing is available for international exchange students
- Link to application for housing will be sent to students by e-mail in April 2020
- Move-in date: 19 June 2020 at 12:00 noon the earliest (Danish time)
- Housing must be financed by the student

Arrival service

- Arrival service is arranged at a hotel near the airport on 19 June 2020, and students will be accompanied to their dormitories.

Social programme

- Social programme is available for students
- Social programme will be announced in spring 2020 - it is a wonderful opportunity for international participants to get to know each other, Copenhagen and the Danish culture through specially arranged activities such as guided city tours of Copenhagen, Danish folk-dancing, comedy night as well as a weekend trip around Denmark.

Introduction meeting

- Date: 22 June 2020. Students get important information about different aspects of ISUP such as studying at CBS, courses and exams, housing etc.

Transcripts

- Transcript will confirm the courses taken and grades received

Visa

- Some students who come to Denmark to participate in ISUP will have to apply for a short-term Schengen visa for the period of the duration of the programme. Since students are going to study in Denmark for less than three months, they will not get a student visa.
